## **IRON AND STEEL**

#### INTRODUCTION

The Malaysian iron and steel industry contributed 2.9% to GDP in 2016 and has the potential to generate up to 6.5% of GDP growth and offer up to 225,000 job opportunities in 2020.

Major export destinations for Iron and Steel products from Malaysia are Mexico, Republic of Indonesia, Thailand, India and Singapore. Major import sources are the Peoples' Republic of China, Japan, Republic of Korea, Taiwan and India.

#### STRUCTURE OF THE INDUSTRY

The structure of iron and steel sub-sector can be classified into two major product groups:

- Flat products such as Hard Rolled Coils (HRC), Cold Rolled Coils (CRC), pipes, tubes and coated coils. These products are used as intermediate raw materials for downstream applications in the sectors of E&E, automotive parts and components, oil and gas, furniture, machinery and equipment and fabricated products; and
- Long products such as billets, steel bars, wire products, angles and sections are primarily used in the construction and civil engineering industry.
