NEW GUIDELINES ON APPLICATION FOR CLASSIC AND VINTAGE VEHICLES IMPORT LICENSE (AP)

(EFFECTIVE ON 1 JULY 2018)

NO	CRITERIA	GUIDELINES
1.	Vehicle Type	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Passenger Car and Motorcycle.
2.	Vehicle Age Limits	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• There are two categories:<ul style="list-style-type: none">i. Classic Vehicles: 35 years and above; andii. Vintage Vehicles: 50 years and above.• For both categories, the vehicle's age is determined based on Vehicle Manufacturing Year.
3.	Vehicle's Condition	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Vehicles must be in good condition and restored to the original factory specification.• Replica or rebuilt vehicles are prohibited.
4.	Classic and Vintage Certification	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Vehicles must be certified as classic or vintage by recognised certification bodies from the exporting or manufacturing country.• All application must include a copy of Certificate of Origin or a Certificate of Registration.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For both documents above, a certified translated version should be included if the language used in the original document is other than Bahasa Malaysia or English.
5.	Applicant Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For individual: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. A Malaysian citizen ii. Have a valid Driving License according to the type of classic or vintage imported vehicle; and iii. Only ONE (1) AP for classic or vintage vehicles is eligible for each individual. • For company: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Registered with the Companies Commission of Malaysia (SSM) as a Private Limited Company; and ii. Have experience in the automotive industry for at least 3 years.
6.	Vehicle Registration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Company must provide a copy of Vehicle Ownership Certificate (VOC) within six (6) months from the date of MITI's approval.
7.	Ownership Restriction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Imported vehicles shall be registered at Jabatan Pengangkutan Jalan (JPJ) and the ownership of the vehicle is non-transferable within five (5) years from the date of first registration at JPJ.

Note: The MITI approved Import License (AP) must be **obtained before the vehicle is imported into Malaysia.**

DOCUMENTS CHECKLIST FOR APPLICATION

Please submit an application letter to MITI and the application must include the following information and documents:

- i. Application letter must include detailed information on vehicles as follows:
 - a. Brand and model;
 - b. Chassis number;
 - c. Engine number; and
 - d. Year of manufacture.
- ii. Vehicle Status Certification as classic or vintage.
- iii. Certificate of Origin/Certificate of Registration.
- iv. Photo of the vehicle.
- v. Purchase order/invoice from seller in export country.
- vi. For application by individuals, the following additional documents should be included:
 - a. Photocopy of identity card; and
 - b. Copy of driving license.
- vii. For applications by companies, the following additional documents should be included:
 - a. Certificate of registration of SSM as a certified Private Limited Company; and
 - b. Experience records in automotive related fields for 3 years.

NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE GUIDELINE

Any application which does not comply with the terms and conditions set out in this New Guideline **will be rejected**.
