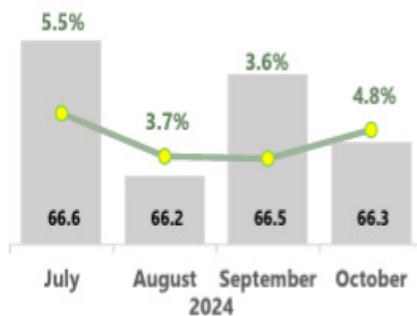

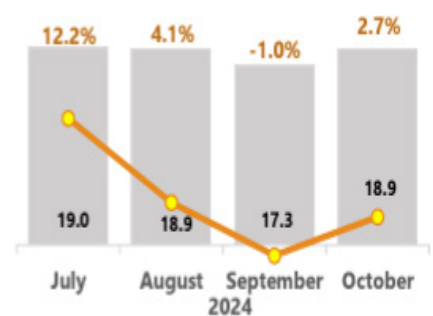

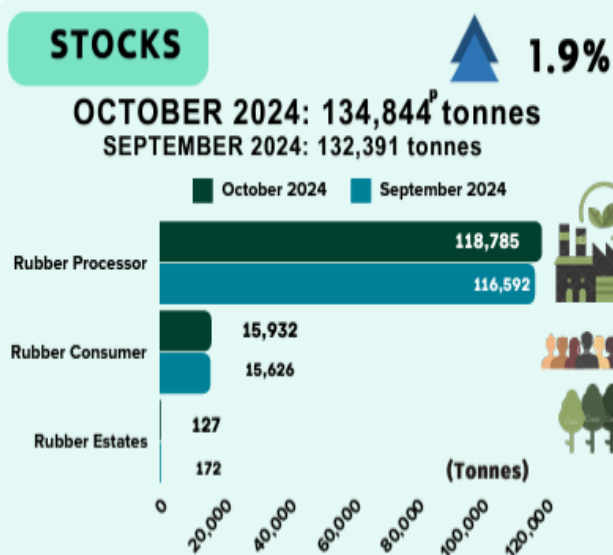

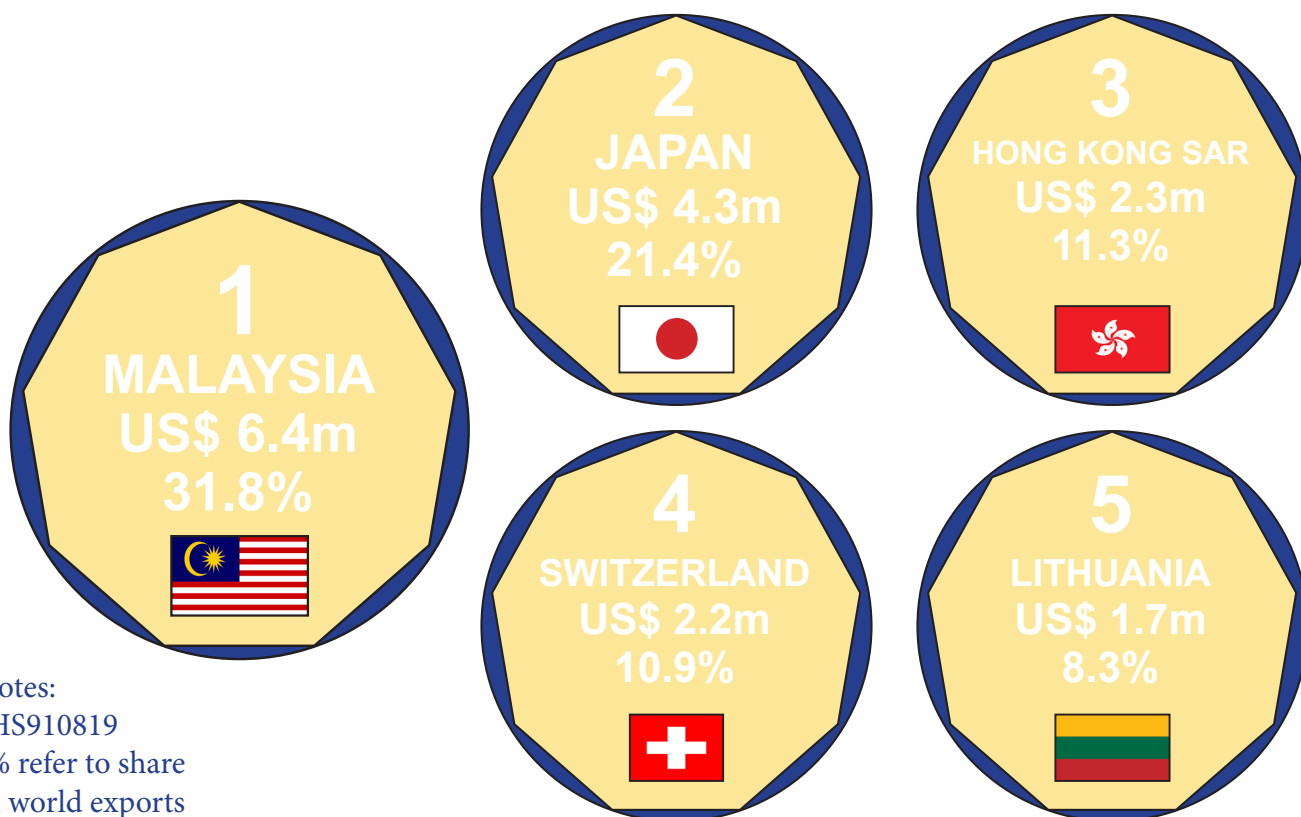

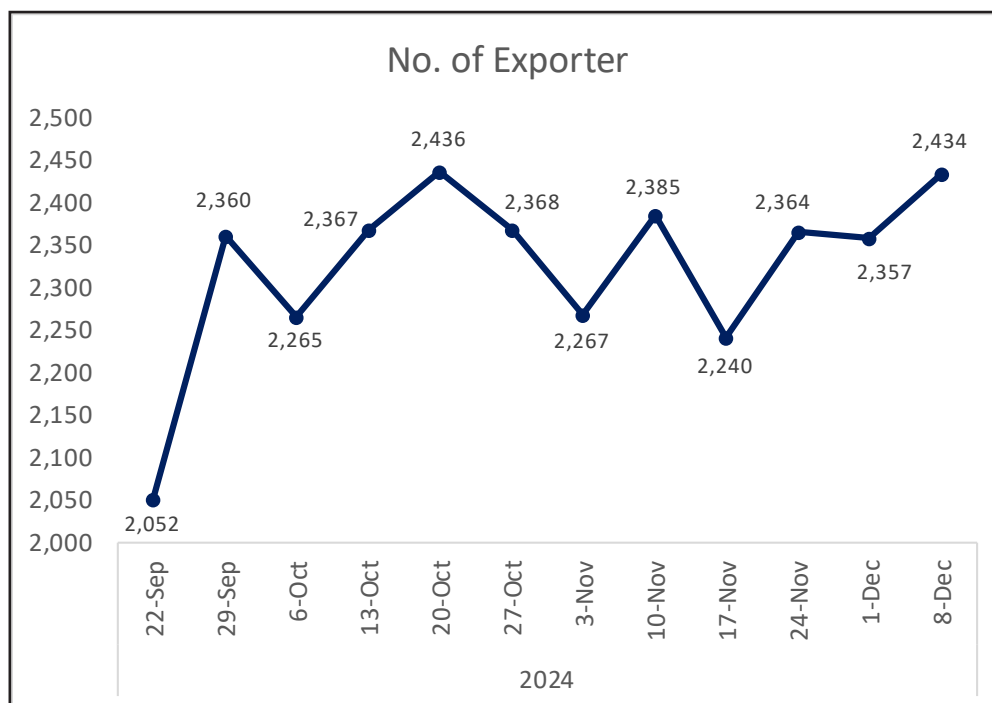
MALAYSIA'S TOP EXPORT DESTINATIONS



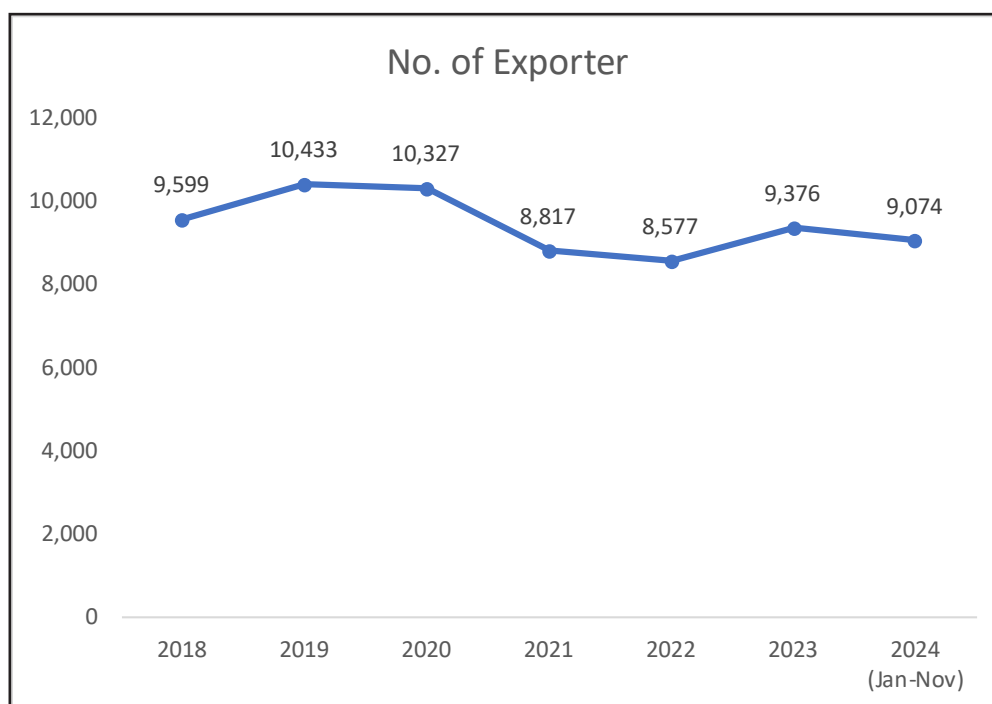
