



INITIATION OF AN EXPIRY REVIEW OF ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES IMPOSED ON IMPORTS OF PREPAINTED, PAINTED OR COLOUR COATED STEEL COILS ORIGINATING OR EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIET NAM

The Government has initiated an expiry review of anti-dumping duties on imports of prepainted, painted or colour coated steel coils (subject merchandise) originating or imported from the People's Republic of China (PRC) and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam (Viet Nam).

The initiation of expiry review is based on the request by CSC Steel Sdn. Bhd. on the grounds that the expiry of anti-dumping duties would likely lead to a continuation or recurrence of dumping and injury to the domestic industry. The Government has evaluated and considered the information, and decided to initiate an expiry review on imports of the subject merchandise from PRC and Viet Nam pursuant to subsection 28C(6) of the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Act 1993 (Act 504) and regulation 34 of the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Regulations 1994 (Regulations). In accordance with the Act 504 and the Regulations, a final determination of the expiry review will be made within 180 days from the date of initiation. The Government has determined Period of Review (POR) for this investigation to be from 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2025.

Relevant interested parties may also provide their views in writing, questionnaires responses and additional supporting information to **MITI by 17 August 2026**. All submissions of information and questionnaire responses must be made by electronic means via the Trade Remedies Investigation Management System (TRIMA), which can be accessed at <https://traderemedies.miti.gov.my>. In the event the relevant interested parties do not provide the necessary information or the information and views are not received in an adequate form within the specified time limit, the Government may make its final determination based on the available facts in accordance with Section 41 of the Act.
