



SME REGIONAL MARKET EXPANSION, FUNDING AND FINANCING: LIMITED SPACES LEFT AT MITI'S WITI FORUM 2025 & ASEAN SME ECONOMIC CONFERENCE 2025

The Ministry of Investment, Trade and Industry (MITI) will host two significant events this week that underscore Malaysia's leadership in promoting inclusive and sustainable economic growth under its ASEAN 2025 Chairmanship (Economic Pillar). The Women in Trade and Industry (WITI) Forum 2025 will take place on 8 October 2025, followed by the ASEAN SME Economic Conference 2025 on 9 October 2025, both at Menara MITI, Kuala Lumpur.

The WITI Forum 2025, themed "Unleashing the Power of Women in ASEAN: Trade and Industry Across Borders" is jointly organised by MITI, HAWA Malaysia, and the Economic Research Institute for ASEAN and East Asia (ERIA). The event aims to highlight the role of women as key contributors to ASEAN's economic resilience and sustainable future and is expected to draw more than 1,000 participants. It will feature engaging knowledge-sharing sessions focusing on women's empowerment in trade and digital innovation, access to finance and markets, leadership and mentorship opportunities, as well as sustainable and inclusive business practices. Subject matter experts from MATRADE, SME Corp, and various ASEAN business networks will share practical guidance on export readiness and international market expansion. YB Senator Tengku Datuk Seri Utama Zafrul Aziz, Minister of MITI, will deliver the Opening Keynote, while YB Dato' Sri Hajah Nancy Shukri, Minister of Women, Family and Community Development, will deliver the Closing Keynote.

On 9 October 2025, MITI will also host the ASEAN SME Economic Conference 2025, with the theme "Unlocking Economic Opportunities for SMEs in ASEAN." The event is organised in partnership with CIMB Bank Berhad as title sponsor, WPP Media and ASTRO. It will gather thought leaders, investors, and entrepreneurs from across ASEAN to explore strategies that can enhance SME competitiveness, strengthen regional integration, as well as improve access to financing and markets. The Conference will feature keynote addresses by YB Senator Tengku Datuk Seri Utama Zafrul Aziz, YB Datuk Ewon Benedick, Minister of Entrepreneur and Cooperatives Development and his Deputy, YB Dato' Sri Ramanan Ramakrishnan.

The Conference's sessions will focus on SME financing, digital transformation, and Alpowered marketing strategies, alongside sharing sessions by regional experts, investors and successful SME founders. Targeting 600 SME participants, it will also feature the launch of a new digital platform designed to support SME internationalisation and facilitate cross-border trade.

In his statement ahead of both events, **Tengku Zafrul** said, "Malaysia's SMEs are the heartbeat of our economy—and they deserve every opportunity to grow beyond our borders. As Chair of ASEAN's Economic Pillar this year, MITI is honoured to co-organise **these knowledge-sharing and networking events** that could help **transform SMEs' businesses from a 'domestic hustle into regional muscle'**. Through **targeted funding, mentorship, regional networks, and strategic Al-powered marketing support,** we are **empowering SMEs to thrive across ASEAN and compete with confidence.**"
