FINAL DETERMINATION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW OF AN ANTI-DUMPING DUTY IMPOSED ON IMPORTS OF COLD ROLLED COILS ALLOY AND NON-ALLOY STEEL ORIGINATING OR EXPORTED FROM THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIET NAM

On 28 July 2020, the Government of Malaysia initiated an administrative review concerning anti-dumping duties imposed on imports of cold rolled coils of alloy and non-alloy steel (subject merchandise) originating or exported from the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam (Viet Nam) based on a petition filed by Mycron CRC Steel Sdn. Bhd. on behalf of the domestic industry producing the like products. The petitioner claimed that there is a substantial change in the dumping margin for the imports of subject merchandise originating or exported from Viet Nam since the imposition of anti-dumping duties on imports of cold rolled coils of alloy and non-alloy steel on 8 May 2019.

In accordance with the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Act 1993 and the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Regulations 1994, the Government has completed the administrative review and determined that the dumping margin has changed for the imports of subject merchandise originating or exported from Viet Nam. Therefore, the anti-dumping duties imposed on imports of the subject merchandise originating or exported from Viet Nam have now been revised as follows:

The Socialist Republic of Viet Nam

(i) China Steel Sumikin Viet Nam Joint Stock Company	: 33.70%
(ii) POSCO-Viet Nam Co., Ltd.	: 7.42%
(iii) Others	: 33.70%

The Royal Malaysian Customs Department will enforce the collection of the revised anti-dumping duties effective from 24 January 2021 to 23 May 2021.
