FINAL DETERMINATION OF AN ANTI-DUMPING INVESTIGATION CONCERNING IMPORTS OF CELULOSE FIBRE REINFORCED CEMENT FLAT AND PATTERN SHEET ORIGINATING OR EXPORTED FROM THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA

On 26 July 2019, the Government of Malaysia initiated an anti-dumping investigation based on a petition filed by UAC Berhad representing domestic producers of cellulose reinforced cement flat and pattern sheet (subject merchandise) in accordance with the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Act 1993 and Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Regulation 1994. The petitioner alleged that subject merchandises originating or exported from Republic of Indonesia (Indonesia) are being imported into Malaysia at a price lower than the selling price in Indonesia and causing material injury to the Domestic Industry in Malaysia producing the like product.

The Government of Malaysia has conducted and concluded the anti-dumping investigation on producers and importer in Malaysia, as well as producer/exporter from the alleged country. The Government has decided to impose definitive anti-dumping duties concerning imports of cellulose fibre reinforced cement flat and pattern sheet and specifically excluding external roofing from Indonesia as follows:

PT Etex Building Performance Indonesia	9.14%
Others	108.1%

The Royal Malaysian Customs Department will enforce the collection of anti-dumping duties on imports of the subject merchandise from Indonesia and this measure will be effective for five (5) years, from 21 March 2020 to 20 March 2025. With the imposition of anti-dumping duties on imports of subject merchandise from Indonesia, it is expected that the issue of unfair trade practices will be addressed.
