NEGATIVE FINAL DETERMINATION IN RELATION TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW (EXPIRY) INVESTIGATION CONCERNING ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES IMPOSED ON IMPORTS OF POLYETHYLENE TEREPHTHALATE ORIGINATING IN OR EXPORTED FROM THAILAND

On 20 April 2016, the Government of Malaysia initiated an administrative review (expiry) investigation concerning anti-dumping duties imposed on imports of Polyethylene Terephthalate (PET) originating in or exported from Thailand based on a petition filed by MPI Polyester Industries Sdn. Bhd. (MPIPI).

The Government of Malaysia based on information gathered during the review has decided to terminate the anti-dumping duty imposed on the imports of PET originating in or exported from Thailand in accordance with Section 28 (6) of the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Act 1993.
