## FINAL DETERMINATION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW OF ANTI-DUMPING DUTY ON IMPORTS OF FLAT ROLLED PRODUCT OF NON-ALLOY STEEL PLATED OR COATED WITH ALUMINIUM AND ZINC ORIGINATING OR EXPORTED FROM TAN PHUOC KHANH TRADING & MANUFACTURING COIL STEEL JSC, THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIET NAM

On 28 December 2022, the Government initiated administrative review on the imposition of anti-dumping duty on the imports of flat rolled product of non-alloy steel plated or coated with aluminium and zinc (subject merchandise) originating or exported from Tan Phuoc Khanh Trading & Manufacturing Coil Steel JSC (TPK), the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam (Viet Nam), whereby the affirmative anti-dumping duties for the subject merchandise was imposed from 12 December 2020 until 11 December 2025, with a range of 4.22%.

In accordance with the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Act 1993 and the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Regulations 1994, the Government has completed the administrative reviews and made a final determination that the affirmative anti-dumping duties and the investigation on the subject merchandise is to be terminated due to the margin of dumping is found to be less than two per centum of the export price (*de minimis*).

The termination of the anti-dumping duties imposed on the imports of subject merchandise originating or exported from TPK will be effective on 27 June 2023.
