FINAL DETERMINATION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEWS OF ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES ON IMPORTS OF COLD ROLLED STEEL COILS ORIGINATING OR EXPORTED FROM THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA AND THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIET NAM

On 28 December 2022, the Government initiated administrative reviews on the imposition of anti-dumping duties on the imports of the following subject merchandises:

- i. cold rolled coils of alloy and non-alloy steel of a thickness between 0.20 millimetres to 2.60 millimetres and width between 700 millimetres to 1,300 millimetres excluding tin mill black plate and for the purpose of automotive end-usage of all grades and specifications originating or exported from the Republic of Korea (ROK) and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam (Viet Nam), whereby the affirmative anti-dumping duties for administrative review were imposed effective from 9 October 2021 until 8 October 2026, ranging from Nil to 33.70%; and
- ii. cold rolled coils of iron or non-alloy steel of width more than 1,300 millimetres excluding tin mill black plate and for the purpose of automotive and finwall for transformer end-usage originating or exported from ROK and Viet Nam. The affirmative anti-dumping duties were imposed effective from 25 December 2019 until 24 December 2024, ranging from Nil to 20.13%.

In accordance with the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Act 1993 and the Countervailing and Anti-Dumping Duties Regulations 1994, the Government has completed the administrative reviews and made a final determination that the affirmative anti-dumping duties and the investigations on both subject merchandises are to be terminated due to public interest. In addition, the termination of anti-dumping duties and the investigation on imports of cold rolled coils of alloy and non-alloy steel of a thickness between 0.20 millimetres to 2.60 millimetres and width between 700 millimetres to 1,300 millimetres excluding tin mill black plate and for the purpose of automotive end-usage of all grades and specifications originating or exported from Viet Nam is due to the margin of dumping is found to be less than two per centum of the export price (*de minimis*).

The termination of the anti-dumping duties imposed on the imports of subject merchandises originating or exported from the ROK and Viet Nam will be effective on 27 June 2023.
