Dear Valued Customer,

NOTIFICATION ON ISSUANCE OF PAPER-BASED FORM D WITH ELECTRONICALLY AFFIXED SIGNATURE AND SEAL FOR APPLICATIONS OF PREFERENTIAL CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN (PCO) UNDER THE ASEAN TRADE IN GOODS AGREEMENT (ATIGA) DUE TO TECHNICAL ISSUE IN MALAYSIA'S GATEWAY

This is to inform that Malaysia's Production Gateway is unable to send or receive ATIGA e-Form D and its related responses due to technical problem. The ePCO System however is not impacted by this and is able to run its normal operations (ie. applying, approving and verifying of Cost Analysis (CA) and Certificate of Origin (CO)).

As an interim solution:

2.	Affected ATIGA applications approved with real-time approval before/on 15 March 2022	The system will uncheck the ASW consent box with remark " ASW consent box temporarily disabled to allow issuance of hardcopy Form D " to allow electronic affixed signature and seal to be generated on the CO	
3.	Affected ATIGA applications approved manually before/on 15 March 2022	The system will uncheck the ASW consent box with remark " ASW consent box temporarily disabled to allow issuance of hardcopy Form D "

PENGUMUMAN

PEMBERITAHUAN MENGENAI PENGETAHUAN BORANG D SECARA HARDCOPY DENGAN TANDATANGAN DAN METERAI DIJANA SECARA ELEKTRONIK UNTUK PERMOHONAN SIJIL TEMPASAL BERKEUTAMAAN (PCO) DI BAWAH PERJANJIAN PERDAGANGAN BARANGAN ASEAN (ATIGA) AKIBAT ISU TEKNIKAL DI MALAYSIA

Dimaklumkan bahawa *Production Gateway* Malaysia mengalami masalah teknikal yang menyebabkan ATIGA e-Borang D dan maklum balas yang berkaitan dengannya tidak dapat dihantar dan diterima. Sistem ePCO walau bagaimanapun tidak terjejas dan boleh beroperasi seperti biasa (permohonan, kelulusan dan pengesahan Analisa Kos (CA) dan Sijil Tempasal (CO)).
