#### MALAYSIA – PRE STA



#### MINISTRY OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE AND INDUSTRY

Scomi Precision Engineering (SCOMI): Malaysia's involvement with the A.Q. Khan network by supplying aluminium centrifuge components in 2003 intended for Libya's nuclear weapons program. This is often cited as among the strongest reasons for Malaysia to implement STA 2010.

AQ Khan is the former head of Pakistan's nuclear programme who sent enriched uranium to Libya and sold nuclear centrifuge parts to Iran. He was operating through an international nuclear trafficking ring. Centrifuge parts manufactured by SCOMI were found on a ship bound for Libya in October 2003. This ship was examined in the Port of Taranto, Italy. SCOMI, admitted making the parts but said it did not know their final destination and believed they were for the oil and gas industries. The middleman/broker involved was BSA Tahir, a Sri Lankan married to a Malaysian. He was based in Dubai. He had a Malaysian PR.


Malaysia was viewed as a <u>transit point for illicit</u> trade of strategic items- mainly to Iran.








## Proliferators exploit the legitimate supply chain to procure export controlled goods for illegitimate means

## HOW?



- Common illicit methods include:
  - Smuggling of goods in comingled shipments;
  - Falsely describing the commodity on export documentation;
  - Falsely stating the end-use and end-user of an item requiring an export permit;
  - Undervaluing the shipment to avoid reporting requirements.
- Transshipment routes are used to exploit favorable trade status with supply/transit countries – using trade facilitation to divert attention for goods meant for restricted / prohibited entity / country.


#### THE COMMITMENT: STA 2010





 UNSCR 1540 – OP3(d) requires all States to:

"take and enforce effective measures to establish domestic controls to prevent the proliferation of nuclear, chemical, or biological weapons and their means of delivery, including by establishing appropriate controls over related materials and to this end shall: ...... establish, develop, review and maintain appropriate effective national export and trans-shipment controls over such items, including appropriate laws and regulations to control export, transit, trans-shipment and re-export....."



As the UN Member State Malaysia is bound by Article 25 and 48 of the UN Charter to comply with and implement these obligations.

## It is an International Practice


 Most countries have some form of strategic trade law enforced in their own country (also known as export control).



## Strategic Trade (Strategic Items) (Amendment) Order 2017

- List out the strategic items that are controlled which can be divided into military items and dual use items
- Adopted from the EU list
- Last updated on March 2017
- Different from Custom HS Code (only 5 digits code)



## **STRATEGIC TRADE (RESTRICTED END-USERS) & PROHIBITED END-USERS) ORDER 2016**



Restricted End User

- Based on country of final destination
- Adopted from UNSC Resolution
- Requires special permit for export of strategic item



Prohibited End User

- List of individuals & entities prohibited from export of strategic items
- Automatic adoption from UNSC Resolution (20 June 2016)
- UNSCR 1718 (2006) Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK)
- UNSCR 2231(2015) against the Islamic Republic of Iran (Iran)



#### **PENALTIES**



#### **Resulting in DEATH:**

- death sentence; or
- Imprisonment: natural life
- (body corporate: ≤ RM 30 million)

#### **OTHER CASE:**

- **Imprisonment:** ≤ 10 years; or
- Fine: ≤ RM10 million; or both

(body corporate: ≤ RM20 million)

**ARMS** RELATED

**MATERIALS** 

- Imprisonment: ≤ 5 years; or
- Fine: ≤ RM5 million; or both
- (body corporate: ≤ RM10 million)



#### **OTHER CASE:**

- **Imprisonment:** ≤ 10 years; or







#### THE REMINDER



- 14. We are seeing acts of terror everywhere. People are tying bombs to their bodies and blowing themselves up in crowded places. Trucks are driven into holiday crowds. Wars are fought and people beheaded with short knives. Acts of brutality are broadcast to the world live.
- 18. This present war against the terrorist will not end until the root causes are found and removed and hearts and minds are won.
- 26. Malaysia hates terrorism. We will fight them.
- 28. Wars are about killing people. Modern wars are about mass killings and total destruction countrywide. Civilised nations claim they abhor killing for any reason. When a man kills, he commits the crime of murder. And the punishment for murder may be death.
- 31. We now have nuclear bombs, capable of destroying whole cities. But now we know that the radiation emanating from the explosion will affect even the country using the bomb. A nuclear war would destroy the world.
