- In today's globalised economy, supply chain disruptions resulting from geopolitical tensions have become the norm.
   Businesses must now plan for resilience, agility, and adaptability. This is where regional cooperation becomes critical.
- 7. Malaysia, as a key player in ASEAN, is committed to fostering stronger regional partnerships to address these challenges. Just a couple of days ago, we concluded the

ASEAN-GCC-China Summit, a historic gathering that showcased the strength and coordination of ASEAN in navigating global challenges. This summit sent a clear message to the world: ASEAN is open for business, and we are ready to lead in building a more resilient and interconnected global economy. Supply Chain City© Malaysia is a testament to this vision, as it will enhance connectivity and facilitate trade between ASEAN and the rest of the world.

- 8. ASEAN is one of the fastest-growing regions in the world, with a combined GDP of over USD 3.6 trillion and a population of more than 680 million people. As the world's fifth-largest economy, ASEAN is a critical player in the global supply chain, accounting for nearly 7% of global trade.
- 9. As the **ASEAN Chair for 2025**, Malaysia is uniquely positioned to **drive initiatives that enhance regional integration and economic resilience.** Our theme for the ASEAN Chairmanship, "Inclusivity and Sustainability," underscores our commitment to fostering innovation, sustainability, and inclusivity across the region.

- 10. Under Malaysia's leadership, ASEAN is poised to address critical challenges such as supply chain disruptions, digital transformation, and climate change. - 11. One of our key priorities is to enhance the ASEAN Single Window (ASW), a digital platform that streamlines trade processes across member states. By reducing bureaucracy and improving trade efficiency, the ASW will play a pivotal role in strengthening regional supply chains and boosting intra-ASEAN trade, which currently accounts for nearly 25% of total ASEAN trade.
- 12. Additionally, Malaysia is championing the development of the ASEAN Digital Economy Framework Agreement (DEFA), which seeks to harmonise digital trade regulations and promote cross-border e-commerce. This initiative will not only enhance digital connectivity but also create new

opportunities for businesses and consumers across the region.

- 13. I am delighted to learn that this development highlights the importance of future-proofing Malaysia's supply chain ecosystem. In line with our commitment to digital transformation, this project also offers the potential for the adoption of smart logistics solutions, further enhancing efficiency and transparency in our supply chains. This aligns with our broader national agenda to embrace the digital economy and leverage technology for economic advancement.
- 15. This initiative reflects our national commitment to **building a high-skilled workforce** that can support Malaysia's

  transformation into a regional logistics powerhouse. Beyond

  its technological advancements, the **project is also**

expected to offer both skilled and semi-skilled job opportunities, further strengthening Malaysia's SMART Warehouse and logistics ecosystem.

16. This investment will play a significant role in fostering local employment and enhancing Malaysia's position as a leader in high-value logistics infrastructure.
