- 6. On top of stimulating production of more advanced vehicles, the New NAP will be a holistic policy that covers the comprehensive development of automotive industry such as development of charging facilities, supply chain, human capital, after market and others.
- 7. The introduction of the New NAP is timely as it will focus on ensuring the domestic industry continues to be competitive with the

emergence of new disruptive technologies which will transform the sector to connected mobility.

- 8. Globally, the automotive sector is going through an exciting phase. Today, manufacturers are continuously expected to develop new models with environmental friendliness in mind, and transportation as a whole is undergoing a rethinking in order to keep the industry sustainable for the future generation.
