- Tonight, we recognise the best of Malaysian Design, the people behind the success, the products and innovations that are shaping Malaysia industries, communities, and our identity.
- 3. I am delighted to extend a warm welcome to our distinguished international guests from <u>Thailand</u>, <u>Singapore</u>, and the <u>Philippines</u>. Your presence this evening greatly enriches our celebration, making this special occasion even more meaningful, particularly in reference to Malaysia's Chairmanship of ASEAN this year.

- 4. I was made to understand that over the past two days, you have participated in the Asia Design Sharing Seminar & Dialogue, organized by the Malaysia Design Council (MRM), an agency under the Ministry of Investment, Trade and Industry (MITI).
- 5. This platform embodies the growing spirit of collaboration among ASEAN nations, a spirit that encourages the exchange of experiences and the creation of a more connected and vibrant creative ecosystem across our region.

## Ladies and Gentlemen,

- 6. Today, design goes beyond aesthetics. It is a strategic tool that drives efficiency, safety, trust, and innovation across sectors, to solve problems and drive competitiveness.
- 7. Good design is infrastructure—invisible but essential. It shapes how people interact with systems, products, and each other. It makes industries stronger, products more 'intuitive' and businesses more strategic.
- 8. From automotive and aerospace to medical technology, furniture, F&B and digital solutions, good design leads creativity to commercial success and innovation to impact. In sharing some examples:

- a. In <u>industry</u>: Good industrial design boosts innovation, improves safety and functionality, and enhances sustainability efforts.
- b. In <u>healthcare</u>: Smart designs save lives by reducing risks and errors, while improving patient experience through healthtech.
- c. In <u>agriculture</u>: Intelligently designed agritech improves productivity, reduces waste and empowers smallholders.
- d. In <u>trade</u>: Smart design builds trust, streamlines logistics, and enhances transportational safety (e.g., avoiding stormy seas and other climate risks)
- 9. But design is also about generating commercial value. In 2023, Malaysia's digital creative sector generated RM5.3 billion in revenue, with exports nearing RM800 million, and more than 10,000 high-skilled jobs created<sup>1</sup>.
- 10. The broader creative economy contributed RM29.4 billion, or about 1.9% of our GDP<sup>2</sup>. As these numbers grow, the message is clear: design is not a luxury, it is a growth driver for Malaysia's economy.
- 11. As we implement the New Industrial Master Plan 2030 and the 13th Malaysia Plan, design will continue play a pivotal role in driving productivity, supporting ESG initiatives and helping our SMEs and large corporations compete globally.

  - i. Encouraging collaboration between designers, manufacturers and academia;
  - ii. Strengthening design standards and certification frameworks; and
