

## **SIRIM QAS INTERNATIONAL GUIDELINES FOR CRITICAL TEST REPORT (CIDB SCHEDULE 4)**

- It is the responsibility of the importers to arrange for cutting of samples at port of entry ( ie prepare the cutting tools, appointment of subcontractors if necessary to cut samples etc.)
- It is the responsibility of the importer to submit samples to SIRIM QAS International Sdn Bhd laboratory.
- The test samples are allowed to be couriered from country of origin provided that they are selected from the consignment to be exported to Malaysia and sampled by overseas accredited inspection body in accordance to ISO 17020 and the test samples shall be accompanied with the letter template.
- The letter template shall be printed on Third Party Inspection Body letter head.

***Note: These guidelines are applicable for critical test at port of entry and only valid for period 1<sup>st</sup> February – 31<sup>st</sup> March 2014.***
